5. Optional: Include where you got the page from, which book/newspaper, author, etc.
6. Optional: Draw or doodle around the words you selected to create an image from your poem.

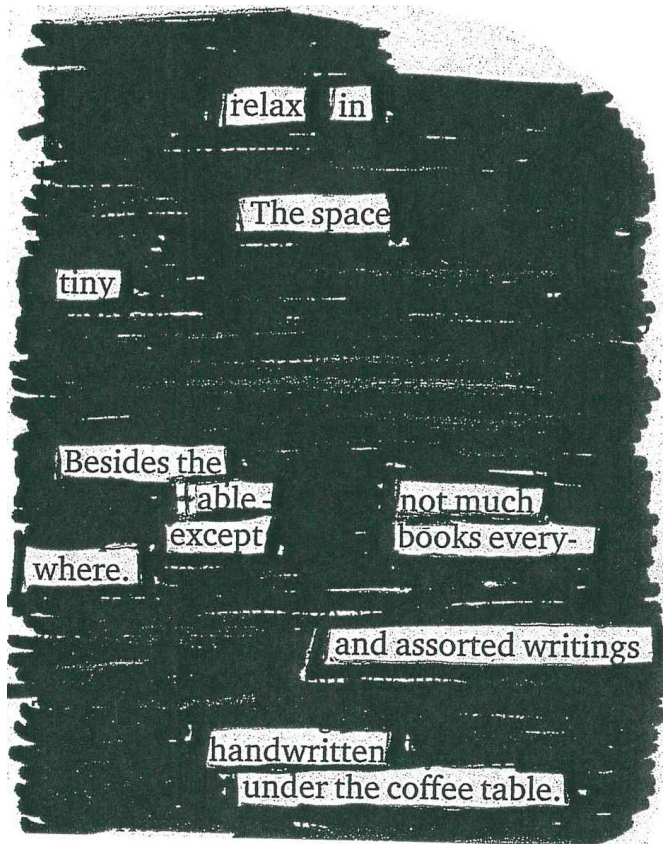
